#### **Dates**

Pre-registration for the 2020-21 school year is **only required for Kindergarten and new students.** For all current students pre-registration will not be required and they will be placed in the next grade. Contact information and demographics will be updated in August. For Grade 5 students moving to Racette from SPECS, registration information will be transferred to us. In August, parents will receive a mail-out with registration papers that will need to be reviewed, signed and returned to the school.

Please note that registration dates and procedures for registration will be dependent upon restrictions on physical distancing, and parents will be notified accordingly.

#### Return of textbooks, library books and laptops


