



Ashmont School Official Opening: Further discussion was held in regards to the grand opening of the new Ashmont School. At this time, due to resuming of outdoor site-works and the delays from a new provincial government being formed, a date will be explored for this event to be held in the fall.

School Fee Review: The Board has reviewed and approved the school fees for the 2019/2020 school year.

ASBA Budget and Bylaws Bulletin: Trustees will review the budget and bylaws bulletin before the spring general meeting held on June 3, 2019.

ASBA Youth Mental Health Summit: Further review and exploration in regards to the summit will take place before a decision is made as to whether or not students from the division will attend.

Action on Smoking: Trustees passed a motion to sign the statement of support for the Tobacco Reduction Amendment Act.

Audit Services Recommendation: After interviewing three firms, the committee has recommended that the services of MNP be retained to complete the required annual audit.

Policy Review: Trustees reviewed Policy 16, Recruitment and Selection of Personnel, and Policy 17, Student Transportation Services.

Alberta Election 2019: The Board congratulated the three successful candidates that serve St. Paul Education, David Hanson, Jackie Armstrong-Homeniuk and Glenn van Dijken, and look forward to meeting with them and working together over the next four years. Due to the new government, SPERD has many variables in terms of budgeting for the upcoming school year.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Despite many unknowns with the upcoming budget, central office personnel has begun working on staffing for the upcoming school year.
- Through the *Together We're Better Project*, Dr. Jody Carrington is presenting to parents and community members at Racette School on April 17th at 7:00 p.m.
- Grade 9 students throughout the division will take part in "Don't Let it be your Last Choice" (former P.A.R.T.Y. program) this spring.

Financial Update

- Trustees received financial information for the month of March.
- A request to use GoFundMe to fundraise for a school event has been tabled to the May 8 meeting. Prior to making a decision, more information is needed from Alberta Education, division administrators, and our auditors.
- The 2019-2020 Division Budget will be reviewed at Board Meetings on May 16 & May 27.

Capital Projects

- A schedule for the completion of the new Ashmont School parking lot was provided by the project manager. The site is tentatively scheduled to be completed by August 15, 2019.
- There is a site meeting in Two Hills on May 6th; the Board hopes to get a schedule at that time for the completion of all exterior site work.
- Myrnam School open house is April 25th, with tours of the CTEC available at that time. The school is hoping to be able to use the CTEC facility by May 1st.
